

Guess the career

How to use this resource.

This activity aims to get students talking about a variety of science careers. It can be used as a starter activity. By directing students to the Future in Chemistry and National Careers Service websites, they can learn about the skills, career paths, and potential earning potential of a variety of interesting careers.

Duration: 5-10mins per image (total of 6 images).

Age group: 11-18years.

1. Print the resource, double-sided (alternatively display as slide).
2. Ask the students to work in small groups to discuss what careers the pictures represent.
3. Encourage the students to discuss, using technical terminology where appropriate, what equipment or skills are evident in the image to support their guesses.
4.
